

SCA Dance Attire

We at St. Catherine Academy know that one can dress fashionably and elegantly while still maintaining modesty.

With that in mind, we offer the following guidelines for dance attire:

Dresses must be longer than the tip of the longest finger. Shoulders must be covered, or straps must be at least 3 fingers wide.

The following are **NOT allowed**:

- strapless dresses
- spaghetti straps
- one-shoulder dresses
- plunging necklines
- plunging cuts in the back
- cutouts on the sides or lower back
- stomach showing
- lacy, see-through dresses with a revealing shell underneath
- Halter-style (open back)
- tight or form-fitting

If a student arrives at the dance with any of the above (or with a dress that is too short, or does not have wide enough straps or shoulders covered), she will be asked to wear a wrap (bolero jacket, shawl, shrug, sweater, etc.) over her dress for the duration of the dance.

If she cannot produce and wear a wrap of any kind, parents will be called to bring one.

If parents cannot provide a wrap of some kind, then the school will provide adequate covering for the student (for example, a men's XL long tee shirt and/or sweatpants to be worn over her dress) if she wishes to stay at the dance.
